

The Commonwealth Fund's Scorecard on State Health System Performance, 2015 Edition, evaluates 42 key indicators grouped into five dimensions: Access and Affordability (six indicators): includes rates of insurance coverage for children and adults, as well as individuals' out-of-pocket expenses for medical care and cost-related barriers to receiving care. Prevention and Treatment (16 indicators): includes measures of receiving preventive care and the quality of care in ambulatory, hospital, and long-term care and post-acute settings. Potentially Avoidable Hospital Use and Cost (nine indicators): includes indicators of hospital use that might have been reduced with timely and effective care management and follow-up care, as well as estimates of per-person spending among Medicare beneficiaries and the cost of employer-sponsored insurance. One indicator, hospital admissions for ambulatory care-sensitive conditions, reported separately for two distinct age groups. Healthy Lives (11 indicators): includes indicators that measure premature death and health risk behaviors. Equity: The scorecard evaluates differences in performance on 33 equity indicators associated with patients' income level (18 indicators) or race or ethnicity (15 indicators) that span the other four dimensions of performance. The data available for some equity indicators, such as childhood vaccinations, may represent a different time point from that used in the corresponding main scorecard indicator. For each state, health system performance on each equity indicator as it pertains to low-income populations (under 200% of the federal poverty level) and racial or ethnic minority groups (black or other race or Hispanic ethnicity) is compared with the national average. The resulting difference in performance is the "equity gap," which forms the basis of our state rankings for this dimension. To support more comprehensive assessment of disparities, the 2015 scorecard expanded the number of indicators evaluated in the equity dimension; hence, the 2015 equity rankings are not strictly comparable to earlier scorecards.

What is on the horizon for Las Vegas healthcare?

Las Vegas is on its journey to becoming the most recognized destination for Global Health & Wellness Travel, a *Medical Tourism Destination*. 




Centennial Hills Hospital



Located in the fast-growing northwest quadrant of Clark County, Centennial Hills Hospital cares for a wide range of medical situations that arise, from accidents at Mount Charleston National Recreation Area to procedures for hearts, spines, and joints.

To accommodate the growing community, the hospital will add a total of 36 inpatient beds through a new fourth-floor expansion project that will increase its total number of inpatient beds to 226. The project is expected to be completed by fourth quarter 2016.

Digital mammography and advanced diagnostic testing are also available.

For those who need surgery, a da Vinci® robotic surgical system can be used for abdominal, gynecological and urological cases. Centennial Hills Hospital also performs over 2,000 orthopedic surgeries per year. This service line is supported by a nurse navigator on the orthopedic nursing unit and the MAKOplasty® system which uses customized technology for hip replacement and partial knee resurfacing, which is the only system in Southern Nevada.

And, for people who may require therapy after surgery, Centennial Hills Hospital offers an outpatient therapy center to assist with the recovery and rehabilitation. Other outpatient services include a new wound healing and hyperbaric medicine center, which is scheduled to open by the fourth quarter 2016.

Desert Springs Hospital is also home to a major weight-loss surgery program, utilizing two Center of Excellence certified surgeons who have performed over 10,000 surgeries, ranging from gastric sleeve to bypass to the new Orbera balloon.

St. Rose Dominican, Rose de Lima Campus




The town of Henderson rose out of a dusty spot of desert in the early 1940s, and its lifeblood was Basic Magnesium Inc., a plant that pulled water and electricity from what was then called Boulder Dam to produce magnesium, a material used for munitions and airplane parts during the war. In 1942, Basic Magnesium Hospital was founded by the U.S. government to provide health care to area industrial workers and their families during the war.

When World War II ended, magnesium production was no longer needed for defense purposes, so many of the 14,000 employees moved away. Basic Magnesium Hospital was put up for sale. The first of the three Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican hospitals, the Rose de Lima Campus was established in 1947 when the Adrian Dominican Sisters of Adrian, Michigan, purchased Basic Magnesium Hospital from the U.S. government for \$1 a year for 25 years. The hospital was the first in southern Nevada to be accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals in 1955 as well as the first in the area to obtain a radioisotope laboratory and the first full accredited cancer treatment center in 1956. It was the first in the state to use a PillCam camera, used to better diagnose diseases in the smaller intestine, in 2002 and the first to be certified by the Undersea and Hyperbaric Medical Society in 2009. A \$25 million, 4-story expansion was completed in 1991 bringing the total square footage to over 220,000 feet housing 119 beds.

The following year the St. Martín Campus became the first hospital in Nevada to offer the Allura Xper FD10/10 Cardiac imaging X-ray System. Located on Warm Springs Road in southwest Las Vegas, the hospital has received numerous awards and recognition for its quality care.

St. Rose Dominican, Siena Campus



The second campus in the St. Rose Dominican hospital network is named after Saint Catherine of Siena. Having dedicated herself to the care of the unfortunate she eventually became canonized in 1461 and in 1970 bestowed the title of Doctor of the Church making the strides she made in healthcare important to the church in perpetuity.

The Siena campus opened in 2000 with 141 patient rooms. In 2012 Siena campus opened on of the first hybrid operating suites in Nevada, a state of the art all-in-one setting in which diagnosis and treatment can take place. In 2015, the Siena campus opened the five-story, 227,000+ square foot Dominican Tower, nearly tripling the original campus total square footage. The tower cost approximately \$160 million and added another 100 private rooms, bringing the Siena campus to 326 beds in total. The number of private emergency rooms has more than doubled. ER treatment and Rapid Medical Assessment spaces have expanded to over 70 rooms and six new operating suites have been added.

In conjunction with adding space the tower will help streamline the hospital experience. The Cardiology Center was expanded to include its own admitting and waiting areas for noninvasive procedures. Outpatient support services have been expanded greatly, including admitting, nutrition services, radiology lab, pharmacy, and endoscopy suites.

Spring Valley Hospital, located in blossoming southwestern Las Vegas, cares for thousands of patients each year. To accommodate the growing needs of the region, a tower will open in the summer of 2016 to provide more private patient rooms. Two more open-heart surgery suites, including one cardiovascular-thoracic hybrid suite, will be available in the fall of 2016.

As a tertiary care facility, Spring Valley Hospital offers advanced medical care in multiple areas. The emergency department uses both chest pain and stroke protocols for the rapid diagnosis, intervention and treatment of these diseases. If necessary, patients can undergo cardiovascular surgery, neurosurgery, or even an interventional procedure to fix brain aneurysms.

With continued growth in its primary service area, the maternity department delivers over 2500 babies each year. Infants who require advanced medical care spend time in the hospital's level three neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), and "NICU graduates" are welcomed back to an annual reunion.

Based upon the age and lifestyle of its residents, a wide range of surgeries are available, including orthopedics, spine, general surgery, and vascular surgery. With its daVinci® robotic surgical system, surgeons use the technology especially for abdominal, gynecological, and urology procedures.

And, when patients need additional expertise to recover from a stroke or other major illness or injury, they can easily transfer to the acute rehabilitation unit on the fourth floor, and, upon discharge, continue with the Outpatient Therapy Center at Spring Valley Hospital. Additionally, a wound healing and hyperbaric center is also available on the hospital's campus to assist patients with chronic and/or non-healing wounds.

Summerlin Hospital



As the only hospital in the 36-square-mile master-planned community of Summerlin, the facility has continually added medical services to benefit more than 100,000 residents in the community and surrounding areas.

Along with emergency and urgent care, Summerlin Hospital features advanced cardiovascular services, oncology and orthopedic care, a robust surgical services program, and a Children's Medical Center. The latter includes a separate pediatric emergency department, general and intensive care units and outpatient services for diagnostic procedures and physical, occupational and speech therapy.

The Children's Medical Center is a natural complement to the busy maternity department. which delivers nearly 5000 babies each year. A level three neonatal intensive care unit is readily available for high-risk, medically challenged and/or premature babies, and an annual celebration reunites former patients with staff and physicians.

The cardiovascular program features balloon angioplasty, cardiovascular surgery, and heart failure procedures. Patients may continue their recovery through an outpatient cardiac rehabilitation program.

Oncology services, including chemotherapy, are available for both adult and pediatric patients, with adults staying within a specialized nursing unit dedicated to cancer patients. Several cancer support groups are hosted at the hospital as well.

Patients also benefit from three da Vinci® robotic surgical systems, which can be used for

a myriad of procedures, including gynecological, obstetrical, urological, colorectal and abdominal procedures. Summerlin Hospital also performs a number of orthopedic procedures, offering pre-surgical education, a nurse navigator on the orthopedic nursing unit, and options for either inpatient rehabilitation or outpatient physical and occupational therapy.

Since 1971, the health care professionals of Valley Hospital have prided themselves on providing excellent patient to their patients. Located in the heart of the Las Vegas Medical District (LVMD) near the government centers and The Smith Center for Performing Arts, it is the founding hospital of The Valley Health System.

Patients who are recovering from a stroke or other major injury or surgery can transfer to the acute rehabilitation unit on the fourth floor for more intensive therapy to aid in their recovery.

A wide range of surgical procedures are also performed at the hospital, with patients benefitting from da Vinci® XI robotic surgery technology used especially for abdominal, colorectal, gynecological and urological surgery. Those requiring inpatient care are directed to one of several nursing units, tailored to their particular post-surgical needs.

As part of the continuum of care, patients and community members can utilize the Diabetes Treatment Center for education and counseling, and the Wound Healing & Hyperbaric Medicine Center for chronic and hard-to-heal wounds.
