



### LEADERSHIP AWARD NOMINEES

### DR. KUMUD ACHARYA

President, Desert Research Institute

Dr. Kumud Acharya serves as President of the Desert Research Institute (DRI), overseeing two state-of-the-art research campuses in Las Vegas and Reno employing 500 scientists, engineers, and research support staff.

Dr. Acharya began his career at the DRI in 2006 as an assistant research professor in hydrology. During his tenure, he has secured more than \$20 million in external research grants

and contracts and helped spearhead some of DRI's largest international collaborations focused on water quality and management. Dr. Acharya's 20-plus years of environmental study have helped local and state water managers better understand the impact climate change has on the region's aquatic ecosystem.

"Innovation is the essence of what we do at DRI. Our team of more than 500 scientists, engineers, and staff are pursuing impactful scientific research and developing inspiring solutions to environmental challenges such as drought, wildfires, and extreme heat to improve the quality of life for Nevadans – and to allow businesses here to thrive."

### DR. DERIONNE POLLARD

President, Nevada State University

Dr. DeRionne Pollard is the current president of Nevada State University, a four-year public institution that is one of the fastest-growing colleges in the country.

She became the first black female president of any Nevada System of Higher Education institution when she began her tenure in August 2021. Earlier this year, Dr. Pollard led a

successful initiative at both the legislative level and with the state board of regents to rename Nevada State College as Nevada State University. She has held previous roles at the College of Lake County and served as president of both Montgomery College and Las Positas College.

"This nomination is representative of a lot of hard work by not just me. Nevada State University exists because we have other people who are profoundly committed to this institution and wanted to see us evolve into this space. I'm grateful for the nomination and look forward to representing my institution well."

The driverless car startup relocated to the Las Vegas region from San Francisco due to Nevada's friendly regulatory environment for autonomous vehicles. The company conducted a four-month beta test of its on-demand electric vehicle service in downtown Las Vegas, before expanding its operations valley wide in late 2022. The cars are remotely controlled by employees in a command center.

The company is investing in closed-loop cooling equipment that effectively eliminates water replacement in the cooling process, which is the first time such a design has been used in a data center in Nevada.
