The state offers a variety of financial incentives to help businesses grow and prosper. Incentives range from hiring and training incentives to tax credits for hiring Nevadans.

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Offset Training Costs

Under a federal program, businesses are reimbursed up to 90% of a new employee's wage and up to a maximum of \$10,000 for on-the-job training. The length of training is dependent on the candidate's current skills and the required skills for the position. Check to see if you might be eligible to take advantage of this funding.



Silver State Works

Through this state program, employers can receive up to \$2,000 per employee in financial incentives or training allowances for new hires. Available incentives include employer-based training, on-the-job training, and incentive-based employment. Learn more about the incentives available and how you can qualify.



Vocational Rehabilitation

This state program offers financial incentives and ongoing workforce development services to businesses that hire people with disabilities. Incentives include a credit for companies that incur expenses to provide access to persons with disabilities, tax deductions for removing barriers to mobility, and a work opportunity tax credit for hiring employees with disabilities. Federal Tax Credits

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) is a federal tax credit available to employers who hire individuals who have consistently faced barriers to employment. Employers may claim a tax credit if they hire an individual who is in a WOTC-targeted group.
